**SUB: REVISION OF STORAGE CHARGES FOR CARGO AT SUTARKANDI.**

The competent Authority has approved the revision of charges for storage of cargo at the Sutarkandi Land Ports as per the rates indicated below: -

S. No	Material	Revised Tariff (Rs.) per day per MT or per CBM			6 <sup>th</sup> day and above
		Up to 24 Hours	2 to 3 days	4 to 5 days	
1	Covered Space	15	25	30	5% increment with respect to previous day
2	Open Space	10	15	20	

**Note:**

1. Packed or bagged material to be stored in covered space and Loose cargo to be stored in open space.
2. Per MT or per CBM- whichever is higher will be charged.
3. Stacking height- Minimum of (3 stacks or 2 meters height).
4. When the cumulative storage charge of items stored at warehouse exceeds 70% of the declared value of the goods, LPAL will have right to auction the item to recover the Storage Charge.
